FINANCIAL LITERACY FOR YOUNG WOMEN

ADDRESSING THE FINANCIAL LITERACY NEEDS OF YOUNG NEET WOMEN TOWARDS THEIR FINANCIAL INCLUSION



The FLY-IN project is being implemented by five partners from Sweden, North Macedonia, the UK, Greece, and Cyprus. It aims to develop an educational programme for youth workers coming from financial institutions, youth centres and educational organisations. The programme will equip youth workers with the tools and knowledge to help young women facing a double disadvantage (e.g. migrant women or NEET- not in education, employment or training) to become financially literate.

The course Curriculum has been developed to provide young women under the age of 25 with the skills and competencies they need to understand various financial concepts, recognise financial risks and opportunities, and to make better financial decisions.
